

BAWLEY POINT RESERVE PROPOSAL FOR A SHELTER AND DOUBLE ELECTRIC BARBEQUE



Shoalhaven City Council, working in consultation with the Bawley Point Kioloa Community Association Inc, proposes to construct a 6x4m skillion roof shelter with double electric bbq and a 3 m long picnic table in Bawley Reserve. The approximate location is to the north of the existing shelter.

The Community might recall Marie O'Connell suggested some time ago at a public meeting that an additional bbq in Bawley Reserve would be a great addition to the existing facilities.

It has taken a little while but the committee has collaborated with council and there is a plan afoot. COMMUNITY CONSULTATION will occur as soon as Covid restrictions allow us to hold a full community meeting

Above is an example of a similar shelter and bbq design.

The shelter would be placed on a concrete slab of 7x5m to allow a 0.5m clearance

Council staff members are working to arrange Crown Land Native Title Assessment, conduct an Environmental Due Diligence check, coordinate a construction crew to inspect the site and comment on proposed slab location/general site conditions and considerations and confirm methods of community consultation needed.

The Bawley Point Kioloa CCB will engage with the Murramarang South Coast Walk coordinators to discuss the proposal in view of their project in regard to the structures in the reserve.

Likewise the BPKCA will investigate repurposing and relocating the small table setting currently in the proposed location in the reserve.
