The Shoalhaven Heritage Strategy is a public policy of the Council. The Strategy provides a framework for identifying, conserving and promoting Shoalhaven's cultural heritage and has supported applications to the NSW Government for grant funding opportunities to assist Council in the delivery of heritage projects and other initiatives.

As a matter of standard practice, public policies are reaffirmed within 12 months of the election of a new Council. Due to community interest, as part of this process Council resolved on 12 August 2025 (MIN25.389) to publicly exhibit the draft Shoalhaven Heritage Strategy for 28 days to enable community input.
