15m²

New small meeting room for workshops, book club, craft and social groups.

STORAGE ROOM (TABLES & CATERING)



15m²

Dedicated storage for tables and Sport & Recreation catering equipment.

BOOK STORAGE & WORKSPACE



36m²

Expansive book storage with workspace and racking system.

COVERED VERANDAH



54m²

Large, covered verandah extends hall capacity and enables all-weather events.

WORKSHOP & ARTS SPACE



42m²

Flexible space for arts, craft, learning, small group activity, history displays and children's learning.
